

LEACH PARK RENOVATION – NOVEMBER 2003



The RNA was awarded a grant to improve Leach Park, located on the west side of the neighborhood at E 28th & K Streets. Brand new playground equipment is being installed, along with sidewalks and extra benches. The RNA Board visited the construction site on November 15, and took photos of the work in progress.



The work is being done by Andersen Pacific Contractors, Inc. of Ridgefield. Pictured are the workcrew: Tim Dull, Jeff Hafford, and Lloyd Dunn. The workmen hope to have the park finished by November 21, 2003. They say the playground equipment is very sturdy, and that the designed assembly is very complex. The photos show the foundation of the equipment as it is

attached to buried footings. Gravel and rubber flooring will be added once the system is completely erected. Also pictured are various schematics of the design plan, and the workmen were busy figuring how each of the components of the playset would fit together. Please stop by the park and watch the changes take place. Once finished, the improved park will be a beautiful and safe addition to the neighborhood!
